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Parking Consultation

Dear Resident

There are a number of locations across the Parish that currently have an issue with either commuter parking or visitors to commercial premises parking for long periods directly outside residents homes.

In response to this we have met the Network Traffic Regulation Officer of Milton Keynes Council to explore what options might be available to help prevent and reduce this issue.

He confirmed that national studies have been carried out which suggested that most commuters would consider parking and walking for 15 minutes to reach a given location i.e. the Bletchley Train Station, rather than pay for parking and suggested a number of options.



We have plotted a 15mins walking zone from the Train Station and your home is within this area. This zone also includes several private roads and some un-adopted streets which would not be included in the consultation as these are not the responsibility of Milton Keynes Council.

Before any changes could take place West Bletchley Council are expected to carry out an informal consultation with affected residents to gather their views. Milton Keynes Council would need to see a 70% return rate with 50% in favour of a particular option before they would consider carrying out a formal consultation with residents.

- ☐ 1) Residents Permit Parking Scheme: This would be suitable for contained roads such as Elmers Park or all of the Bletchley Park Estate. The current cost to the resident is £25 per vehicle, per year, visitors would be able to purchase day passes.
- ☐ 2) Residents Permit Parking Place or Area: This could operate on a complete road or a particular section of a road. The current cost to the resident is also £25 per vehicle, per year, visitors would be able to purchase day passes.
- ☐ 3) Short Stay Parking: This is a timed restricted parking area, such as No Parking between 11am and 1pm, thus preventing all day parking and could be specific to weekdays only.
- ☐ 4) I wouldn't support any of the options above.
