Reference Block G and Filming for 'Pennyworth'

As you may remember from my previous correspondence I am the asset manager, and point of contact for the new owners of Block G and the Wartime Canteen.

I wanted to let you know that Block G has been selected as a location for some filming next week, for a new 10 part series rooted in the DC Graphic Novels Universe.

This is a test project to understand if the site can be used in such a way from time to time prior to any material improvements to the site. As such we have been working hard behind the scenes in the last few weeks to put in place elements of the contract to ensure our neighbours are carefully considered throughout.

Our Community Management Team at Places Made will be on call throughout the period, to answer any questions, or deal with any issues should they arise. Emma James at Places Made will also liaise with an onsite community liaison officer from the production company who will be at Block G throughout the period the production team are on site.

After the filming is complete Emma will also compile a small report for me to review, highlighting any challenges that might have arisen that would need consideration for any further filming in the future.

What is Pennyworth?

A ten-part series rooted in the DC universe, exploring the backstory of an iconic character. A young, former SAS officer living in London. He must navigate friendships, romance while continuing to establish himself as a prominent figure within the underground community of the capital and carve out a career in the most unlikely settings. Though he claims to crave the simple life, he is repeatedly pulled into dangerous situations that utilise his unique skill set and satisfy his craving for living on the edge.

Parking:

We currently plan on parking most vehicles in a nearby hard standing area within the Bletchley Trust site where we are doing additional filming to prevent a huge presence coming through the residential neighbourhood. Additional vehicles will be parked inside the Block G hoardings. We will aim to minimise the vehicles coming through the residential areas.

Lighting:

We may have some light pollution spilling from the set due to our large production lamps. None of this should be outside of the above hours. If you are concerned about light pollution please do contact me on the email below and I'm sure we can help with providing a temporary solution to help if we feel you will be effected.

Covid-19

We would like to assure you that we have strict Covid-19 safety protocols in place and adhere not only to the government guidelines but also more stringent protocols set out for our industry.
