We are living at Bletchley MK3 6DF opposite MK College. Your staff who been very looking after our area. He is the man who has long beard.

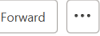
He kept our street very clean during the work in processing in the college.

- Over the next few months,
 - The steel frame will be up in readiness for the second phase.
 - Windows and glazing will be replaced
 - Externals works will continue along with landscaping of the area.

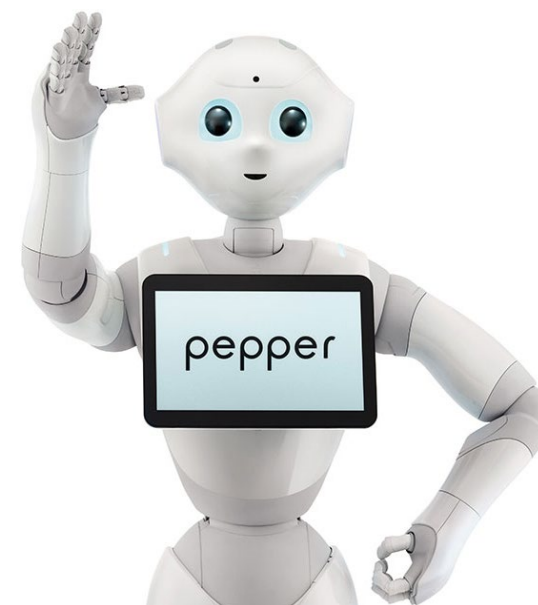




Commitment to Social Value

Ashe have produced a large Social Value programme that offers some of the following:

- Up to 50% of trades from local suppliers, creating up to 10 apprenticeships, 13 work placements and 5 local job adverts, already placed.
- Work with local charities, a bike ride is being organised with all donations going to local charities.
- Engaging with the Sustainability agenda, Ashe have currently found other uses and users of materials, diverting over 12.56 tonnes from landfill sites.
- Last year Ashe committed £10k for Christmas hampers to be delivered by college staff including the project team to students and members of the public.
- Competition for students to design and work with trades within the construction industry, also for students to see how technology is employed.
- Ashe are also working with the project to communicate and update any local interested parties on the progress of the build programme.

TECH PARK BLETCHLEY

Tech Park Bletchley will inspire digital futures through the facilitation of digital learning for the communities of Bletchley and Fenny Stratford

The Project will invest in hardware and equipment that will facilitate the delivery of both basic digital skills as well as specialist digital skills. Tech Park Bletchley is adopting a 'tech agnostic' approach with investment in a range of hardware and software from different suppliers and brands, including Apple and Microsoft.

A mobile provision will enable the equipment to be taken out and used in a range of locations in the community, supported by the South Central IOT team and Pooleyville.
